**MARAETAI DRIVE**  
**STOP-GO: 7:00am - 9:00am**  
 a STOP-GO will be in operation from the eastern side of Te Puru Park to the west of Omana Esplanade. EXPECT DELAYS



**OMANA ESPLANADE**  
**ROAD CLOSED: 7:00am - 9:00am**  
 Omana Esplanade closed for entire length. Note that returning runners in the half marathon later in the morning (9am-11am) will use the footpath. RESIDENT ACCESS MAINTAINED

**MARAETAI COAST RD & NORTH RD**  
**LANE CLOSED: 6:30am - 11:00am**  
 Maraetai Coast Road and North Rd north of Duder Regional Park entrance is open for WESTBOUND travel only (Clevedon -> Maraetai). EASTBOUND traffic should follow DETOUR via Whitford and Brookby.
